

PRAYER WARRIORS FOR PRISONERS  
STATE OR REGIONAL COORDINATOR - JOB DESCRIPTION

Represent PWFP in a way that is pleasing to God.

1. Oversee the PWFP state office and remain in contact with PWFP headquarters.
2. Maintain the state data base, office equipment and supplies.
3. Maintain the Post Office box.
4. Recruit volunteers for office work
5. Recruit and screen volunteers for prison mission teams.
  - A. Volunteers to present the Gospel
  - B. Volunteers to lead worship
  - C. Volunteers to present PWFP ministry to inmates.
6. Submit Prison Ministry Articles for newsletters
7. Recruit volunteer prayer warriors.
8. Solicit churches, groups and individual donors for financial support
9. Maintain the Mission and goal of Prayer Warriors For Prisoners.
10. Contact churches to arrange appointments with pastors and other outreach mission personnel.
11. Arrange church and groups presentations of PWFP.
12. Arrange promotional interviews with broadcasting networks (radio and television).
13. Write mission solicitation letters for personal support.
14. Coordinate fund raising events to finance PWFP ministry in your state.
15. Maintain the data base for the state for incarcerated individuals as well as those who are released. This information will help track statistics of recidivism
16. Copy PWFP prayer forms to take to prison services.
17. Prepare reports of growth and statistics for the PWFP international office.
18. The state coordinators in larger prison population states would be in charge of regional coordinators for their state.
19. Coordinate the Christmas card project for your state
  - A. Recruit churches and volunteers to send cards
  - B. Coordinate with chaplains for prisoner sign up sheets from facilities in your state or region.
  - C. Enter data for the card project and prepare labels for volunteer coordinators of each group.
  - D. Supply information and recruit volunteers. Attend and oversee Christmas card parties.
20. Hold prayer meetings in various regions to honor God first and He will make the increases in each area.
21. Be accountable to God and PWFP international leadership for the highest moral and ethical standards established by God's Word.

**HISTORY OF PWFP:** Prayer Warriors For Prisoners was birthed out of the need for each prisoner to have someone praying for their specific needs. It began in 1987 in a small Bible study at the Colorado Women’s Correctional Facility when Jan McLaughlin asked 19 women prisoners if they would each like to have their own personal “prayer warrior.” The ladies were astounded that someone they didn’t know would care enough to pray for them. They all filled out prayer request cards which were assigned to 12 praying volunteers who had agreed to pray for their specific requests.
